Today, India produces 24% of the total world milk production, amounting to 221 million tonnes, showing 5% increase over last year. Out of the total milk produced, only 25-30% is handled by the organised sector, and hence, there is a tremendous scope for the dairy industry to grow and serve the nation by providing safe and secure milk and milk products.

The success of the dairy industry depends on the success of dairy farms. Under Indian conditions, making dairy farms sustainable has several challenges. ### About ICRTC

Agricultural College Dairy Farm, Pune was started in the year 1878 in the Greater Bombay State. The College of Agriculture was established in the year 1907. Besides the UG and PG teaching, presently four research projects are in progress in the division of Animal Husbandry and Dairy Science section, Agriculture College, Pune. The Indigenous Cattle Research cum Training Centre (ICRTC) was established with the great support of the Maharashtra Government. The centre has 11 indigenous cattle breeds. A comparative study of production and reproduction performance of five indigenous cattle breeds viz; Gir, Sahiwal, Rathi, Tharparkar and Red Sindhi are in progress. The ICRTC uses IVF/ET technique at the farm and field level for increasing the number of elite indigenous cattles. The ICRTC has developed a sustainable model of dairy farming by establishing a demonstration unit of five indigenous cattle breeds, Herbal Garden, Biogas, PROAM Unit, Milk Processing Unit, Cow Urine and Dung Processing Unit. The division is also working on a project under Climate Change and Strategies for Better Adaptation and Mitigation for Sustainable Livestock Production. The 'Cow Tourism' project is also in progress. This section has been working on developing IoT enable livestock management systems and also on developing smart software for the dairy.


### **ABOUT BAIF**
